Full Paper: The content of the papers submitted should be scientific, advanced, innovative, and must not have been published in any academic journals or reported in any prior academic meetings. The corresponding author of the selected paper will be invited to make a presentation in the 15th IACMAG International Conference, and the deserving manuscripts will be introduced to the *Journal of Rock Mechanics and Geotechnical Engineering*, *International Journal of Geomechanics*, *Environmental Geotechnics* and *Ground Improvement*.

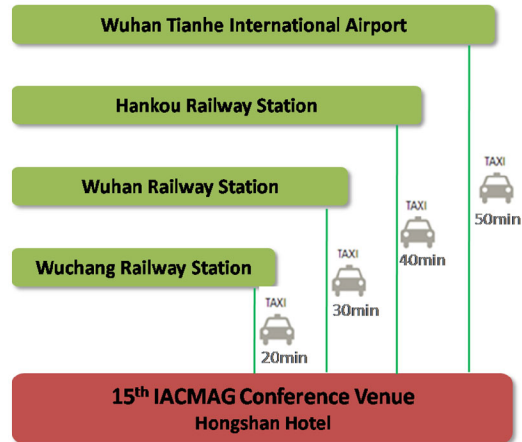

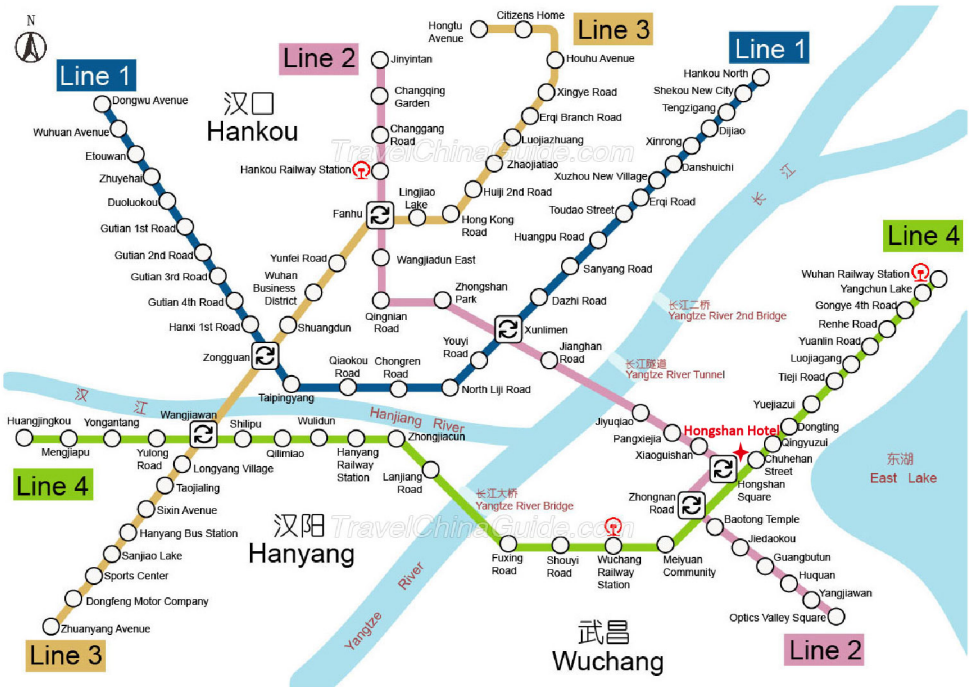

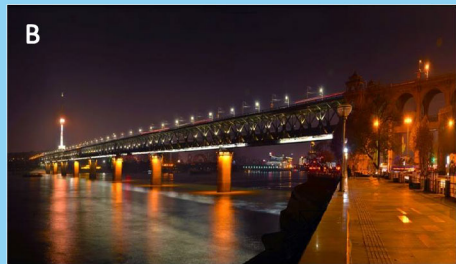
